Please note: For WATER EVENTS

Newfoundland Club Insurance requirements insist that buoyancy aids be worn when in or on the water and that wet /dry suits be worn when in the water at a water event

All dogs must wear a suitable life jacket and harness if required to supplement the life jacket that are strong enough to enable a dog to be lifted into a boat in an emergency. This life jacket / life jacket & harness combination should have a handle or suitable area for a person to hold on for a safe tow to shore.

Rules and Regulations

All owners of entrants are encouraged to study the requirements of the tests for which they are entered. - No dog may be entered for a test unless it has successfully completed all the preceding tests, at previous events organised by either the Newfoundland Club, The Northern Newfoundland Club or The Southern Newfoundland Club.
- 3. N/A

Newfoundland Club insurance demands that people entering the water have to wear a wet/dry suit and MUST wear a buoyancy aid/life-jacket. People in boats MUST wear a buoyancy aid; unless they are going into the water, when they MUST comply with the above.

- 4. Tests will commence for draught at 9:30am
- 5. All entrants must attend the Judges briefing at the appointed time. Entrants who miss the briefing will only be admitted under special circumstances and at the discretion of the Test Manager.
- Owners must be responsible for the control of their dogs at all times. Exercising of dogs within the defined test area is prohibited. Any dog when not in the test area must be kept on a lead.
- 7. Smoking is not permitted in the test area.
- 8. N/A

Excepting for a dog under test, no dog may enter the water except at a designated warm up area, at any time during the tests. Any entrant in breach of this regulation will be liable to disqualification.

- 9. The Working Committee reserves the right to refuse any entries.
- 10. Every entry form must be completed and accompanied by the correct fees or it will not be accepted. Entry fees will not be refunded except by permission of the Working Committee.
- 11. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement the Working Committee reserve the right to appoint another judge in his/her place. Entrants may withdraw from the tests, but no fees will be refunded.
- 12. Acknowledgement for entrants will not be sent out. Any person requiring acknowledgement of entry must enclose an SAE with their entry form.
- 13. A dog will be disqualified and removed from the event if it is:
 - a) A bitch which is in season.
 - b) Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease.
 - c) Interfering with the safety or chance of success of any other entrant.
 - d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to itself or any other person or animal.
 - e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to take part in tests.
- 14. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the event.
- 15. Every effort will be made to test all entrants on the day of the event, if however, due to the number of entrants or circumstances beyond the control of the Working Committee this is not possible, any untested entrants will have their entry fees refunded.
- 16. The Judges' decision in all matters relating to the tests is final.
- 17. If insufficient entries are received by the closing date for entries, the test Manager has authority to cancel a part of, or the whole event-Judges, Stewards and Entrants will be notified accordingly.
- 18. Anyone wishing to attend this event as a spectator only, **please contact the Test Manager** within two days prior to the date to verify that the event has not been cancelled.
- 19. The Newfoundland Club cannot accept any responsibility for any accident or injury to persons or dogs at the event.

This form must be completed by one person (or partnership) only. The writing must be BLOCK CAPITALS in ink.

Use one form for each dog entered for entire event.

Enter details carefully - these will be used when completing pass certificates.

Dogs must be of correct age on day of test. On no account will entries be accepted without fees.

DRAUGHT Beginners: 12 Months, Level 1: 18 Months, Level 2&3: 24 Months, Level 4: 30 Months and less than 8 years.

WATER Section A: 6 Months, Section B: 9 Months, Section C: 18 Months, Section D&E: 24 Months.

A dog can only be entered for **one** level at draught, and **one** at water per day.

Please note, dogs who pass **level Beginners/Section A** may enter for **level 1/Section B** on the day/event, subject to time being available, at an additional cost of £3.50 NC or SNC members (£5.00 for non-members).

All dogs **MUST** have obtained a pass at each level of test, commencing at **the beginning**, before entry is permitted to the next level. Only passes obtained at events organised by the Newfoundland Club, the Northern Newfoundland Club or the Southern Newfoundland Club will be recognised as relevant qualifications for this event.

Non NC or SNC Member £9.50 for the first test £5.00 for each subsequent test




